

URGENT APPEAL: Let Us Keep The Doors To Educational Opportunities Open!

For the past 8 years, our sponsored children at the Salvation in Christ Orphanage and Humanitarian Refuge Home, Inc. (SIC) in Liberia, West Africa have attended the ENMA school operating within the SIC compound. The "rent free" arrangement with ENMA, allowed the SIC children to attend



school "tuition free." Prior to the opening of ENMA, LO/HP, Inc. always provided full education scholarships to private community schools for all our sponsored children, youth and young adults to ensure quality education.

However, as we announce in our last Newsletter, the education building that LO/HP, Inc. built over 14 years ago has been found to be structurally unsound and unable to support the average 200+ students. Initially, we started making appeals for the \$4,000US for corrective actions. Then, other major issues surfaced and now, our best course forward is to demolish the building and eventually rebuild, as funding becomes available.

In the interim, closure of the "tuition free" school has caused an unexpected financial crisis, as LO/HP, Inc. is already funding the entire operations of this orphanage home. There are 39 children, 24 girls/ 15 boys, with the youngest age 4 in kindergarten and the oldest age 20 in the 11th grade who are depending upon us for their education this year. Thankfully, negotiations with the schools have resulted in significant student discounts and a payment plan. The full negotiated cost of \$4,500US covers testing, registration, tuition, school and gym uniforms, school and gym shoes, socks and school supplies, averaging \$118US per student. Below are those who are in immediate need of an education scholarship!



We are seeking donors for our Operation Blessing Project. Thirteen thousand (\$7,000US) is needed to send a humanitarian aid containers to Liberia, West Africa to distribute thousands of relief items, educational materials, recreation items, and medical supplies to orphanages, child welfare homes, the Blind, seniors, clinics, and the poor in urban / rural areas.
